The Southfield Chapter of Silhouettes was founded in 1997 as a result of the Southfield Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. serving as hosts for the Province that year. After the Province, we decided to become an official Silhouette Chapter. The first officers were: Wendy Sanders, President; Sharon Richardson, Vice-President; Shirley Griffin, Treasurer; and Delores Stokes, Secretary.

-  ***Over the years we have won numerous awards: second place nationally for best service project; at the province level – best service project, most new members, most people to register at a province, best display board, and the list goes on.***
-  ***We have both started our own service projects and supported others. In 1998-1999, we adopted the Franklin Elementary School in Pontiac, MI. We worked with a third/fourth grade class – we celebrated holidays with them, took them on field trips and visited their classrooms.***
-  ***We participated in community outreach efforts of the Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP) for approximately two years (2002-2005). We volunteered to reach out to the general public by donating time to man booths and provide information for free mammograms and cervical cancer screenings for low income women between the ages of 40-64.***
-  ***We choose a family each year to support during the Christmas Holidays. Each Silhouette buys a gift for one of the children. However, during the last few years, we have been purchasing gifts for young ladies at the Vista Maria Home. We also donate clothes and personal hygiene items to the girls as needed.***
-  ***We participate annually in the Race for the Cure event held at Comerica Park in Detroit, MI.***
-  ***In August 2006, we sponsored our first Rally for the Cure Golf Tournament to raise funds for the Susan G. Koman Breast Cancer Foundation. We have had a tournament each year since that time. We have raised over \$25,000 up to this point.***

-  *In 2001, we established the Wilberta Brown Memorial Scholarship in memory of our beloved Silhouette sister who died of breast cancer that year. Since then, we have donated \$1,000 each year for a scholarship and have renamed the scholarship to the Southfield Silhouette Memorial Scholarship in memory of all of our beloved sisters who have passed away.*
-  *As a result of the Southfield Silhouettes, we formed the Teezers Golf League and we are still playing over twelve years later. Currently we are playing on Fridays at the Farmington Hills Golf Course.*
-  *We also started an Investment Club which lasted for about six years.*
-  *In December 1998, we had our first Christmas party to bring in the Christmas Season with our husbands. The first party was held at the home of Delores Stokes and we have since had it at various locations.*
-  *We hold an annual Pamper Party where we spend a day of fun together enjoying massages, facials, manicures, pedicures, yoga, card games, conversations, great food and drinks!*
